


GPAC Meeting Procedures

What is the General Plan?

"Blueprint" for Growth & Development

- Establishes community vision and supporting goals, policies, and actions
- Provides consistent direction for future development
- Balances growth, conservation, and quality of life
- Documents baseline environmental conditions



General Plan "Elements"

» Required:

- Land Use and Community Design
- Circulation
- Housing
- Natural Resources and Conservation
- Open Space and Agriculture
- Health and Safety (including Noise)

Custom to Hollister:

- Community Services and Facilities
- » New Elements as part of this update:
 - Arts
 - Economic Development

» Last Updated: 2005

- » Engage broad spectrum of the community
- Establish the community's vision for Hollister in 2040
- » Maintain small town agricultural character
- Manage growth consistent with community goals
- » Ensure high quality development
- » Support economic development
- » Respond to State mandates and General Plan Guidelines







| Draft General Plan | December 2020 - Fall 2021 |
| Other Work Products | Summer 2020 - Fall 2021 |
| Environmental Impact Report | December 2020 - Fall 2021 |
| Public Review and Adoption | Fall 2021 – Winter 2022 |



General Plan Advisory Committee Role

Two main functions, both of which are of equal importance:

- » Review and make recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council on work products that will form the content of the General Plan Update.
- Serve as project ambassadors to spread the word about the General Plan Update, encourage participation, and build community support for the General Plan Update.

GPAC Meetings

- » 10 meetings planned
- » Usually 2 hours per meeting
- » Meeting materials will be available online the Friday before the meeting


GPAC Public Interface

- » Coordinated approach to gathering public comment
- » Listen to input
- » Answer factual questions
- » Limit decision-making to GPAC meeting
- » Report significant interactions
- » Defer formal opinion gathering to staff/consultant team



Brown Act Requirements

- Ensure equitable public participation in government decision-making
- » Meeting Notice and Agenda must be posted
- » Meetings are open to the public
- » Opportunity for public comments at every meeting
- » Serial/group email prohibited subcommittee discussions must take place at public meetings



Public Comment and GPAC Discussion

Chair and Vice-chair Election

- » Role of Chair:
 - Open and close the meeting
 - Ensure meeting follows proper process
- » Most GPAC presentations and facilitation by PlaceWorks consultant team

Vacant GPAC Seats

- » Two vacant seats:
 - Planning Commissioner
 - Public at-large
- » Consider making a recommendation to Council on how to proceed




